1 ANNOUNCEMENT

Berwick & District Motor Club will organise a 12 Car Clubman Status Navigational Rally on Saturday 8th of April 2017. Starting from, Lilburn Estate, Wooler, Northumberland.

2 JURISDICTION

The meeting will be governed by the General Regulations of the MSA Ltd (incorporating the provisions of the International Sporting Code of FISA) and these Supplementary Regulations, together with any other written instructions that the organising Club may issue for this event.

3 AUTHORISATION

The Authorisation Permit has been applied for.

4 CHAMPIONSHIP

The event is a round of the Berwick & DMC Club Championship.

5 ELIGIBILITY

The event is open to all fully elected members of the promoting Club. All competitors (driver and navigator) must produce a valid membership card at signing on.

6 PROGRAMME

Scrutineering starts at 17.00 hrs. Any competitor not signed on by 18.00 hrs may be penalised 10 marks/per minute late. First car starts at 18.01 hrs.

7 FORMAT

Cars will leave MTC1 at one minute intervals.

The event will have a total mileage of approximately 50 miles.

Map number 74/75 will be required.

Crews will need to be equipped with the following Romer, Rubber and Pencil (these will also be available from the club before the start)

Types of navigation which may be used: References i.e. Ball & Arrow, Grid, Tulip, Spot Heights and Plotting.

Crews will be supplied with time cards at the start. These documents will provide all the information necessary to comply with R14.

The finish will be at Branxton Village Hall, Branxton, Cornhill on Tweed, TD124SN

8 CLASSES

The event will consist of two classes as follows:

Class A – Expert. A navigator/crew who in the eyes of the organising team do not deserve to be a newcomer and would only have been in this class pot hunting.

Class B - Newcomers. A navigator/crew who in the eyes of the organisers deserve to be in this class.

9 AWARDS

1st o/a Expert or Newcomer crew – An Award / Trophy

1st & 2nd Driver & Navigator – Engraved Awards – Expert

1st & 2nd Driver & Navigator – Engraved Awards – Newcomers

Assuming class minimum. No crew may win more than one award.

10 ENTRIES

Entries open on publication of these regs and close on Friday 7th of April 2017. The maximum entry is 12, the minimum is 6. The maximum for each class is 12, the minimum is 3. Should any of the above minimum figures not be reached, the organisers have the right to cancel the meeting or amalgamate classes.

The entry fee is £15.00. All entries must be made on the official entry form and be accompanied by the appropriate fee

12 PENALTIES

Marking and penalties will be as per the 'time' penalties section of the MSA General Regulations except as modified below:

Checks will be established to ensure compliance with the intended route; these will take the form of code boards, marshal's signatures or stamp. Crews are reminded to stay outside the control board until your time arrives to avoid congestion at the control.

All other General Regulations of the MSA apply as written, except for the following which have been modified:

R13 a) Exclusion

R13 b) 30 marks per offence

R13 c) 15 marks

R13 d) 15 marks per offence

R12.1 Scheduled timing will be used

R11.1 Controls will be open 15 minutes before the due time of the first car, and close 30 minutes after the due time of the last car

R15.2.2 Will be used in the event of a tie then smallest engine capacity (super charged/turbo plus 70%)

R18.5 Max 4 forward facing lights

Appendix 2-25. For the purpose of tie deciding 1 section may be timed to less than 1 minute

14 GENERAL

a) Provisional results will be published as soon as possible after the end of the event or by despatching a copy in writing by post within 14 days of the event.

b) Any protests must be lodged in accordance with 05.1.

c) Competitors will be required to make up lateness by use of R12.7. Servicing will not be permitted from outside sources.

d) Competitors will be identified by numbers (size 4.5 x 4.5) which will be provided by the organisers and will be placed on the top left of the screen.

e) All cars must carry a warning triangle during the event.

15 INSURANCE

The club has applied to Chaucer Insurance (REIS) for a Blanket Cover Note. This will provide Competitors who need to use the scheme with the Third Party Cover necessary to meet RTA requirements.

The basic rate for the Event (before any Loadings) will be £15.00
