Thank you for your entry to this year's event, you will find your start number on the attached entry list. Please read the following information which contains things you should be aware of.

1. Authorisation

Motorsport UK Permits numbers 135977 (Historic) and 135978 (Targa) have been issued.

RSAC Route Authorisation TBC

DOE Route Authorisation 063/24 has been issued.

2. Starting Procedure

MTC 1 and MTC3 are located at the exit from the Black and Gold Club 75 /991 517. You must start from MTC1 at your scheduled time (13:00 plus your car number). Car 0 start time at MTC3 is 09.30. For your start time add your car number in minutes. At the Sunday Coffee Halt (MTC4) there is no IN control, just a card collect point. Please ensure that you check out of Coffee Halt MTC4 on your due time. Car 0 start time at MTC4 is 11.35. For your start time add your car number in minutes.

3. Scrutineering and Documentation

- Documentation will be at the Black & Gold Club from 10:00 on Saturday 4 May. Please pick up your documentation before proceeding to Scrutineering.
- Scrutineering will be held at Tweedmouth Service Station 75/ 989 524 commencing at 10.00 on Sat 4 May. (see Location map provided)
- To minimise queuing please try to arrive using the following scheduled

Cars 1-20 between 10:00 and 11:00

Cars 21-40 between 11:00 and 12:00

Cars 41-60 between 12:00 and 13:00

- Every competing car will be subject to a noise test. Maximum permitted noise level being 98db at two thirds maximum rpm.
- The car entered must "taxed" for use on the public road unless it is exempt by age or other class of exemption.
- •The car must have a current MOT unless of an age which gives exemption.
- •Please also remember the following must be carried in the car:
 - Small Spill Kit to Motorsport UK specification
 - Warning Triangle
 - First Aid Kit
- Strongly Advised are
 - Fire Extinguisher (Hand Held)

- •As per the SRs Only E marked road pattern tyres will be permitted. Tyres marked for "competition use only "are not permitted. Studded tyres are not permitted.
- •Ensure the positive terminal of the battery is covered with non-conductive material.
- The Scrutineering team may undertake spot checks for compliance with Noise and Technical requirements of the vehicles throughout the event.

Tweedmouth Service Station is a Mitsubishi main dealership and will be open to customers during scrutineering, please act responsibly and show respect for staff and customers.

After scrutineering please proceed to Black and Gold Club without delay.

5. Timing

Ensure that you set your clocks to rally time. A clock showing Rally Time will be available at the Black and Gold Club before the start.

No test or regularity will open prior to the due time of Car 0 thereafter you may start whenever you arrive.

There is 30 minutes penalty free lateness at all time controls. (With the exception of Regularity IRTCs!) If you are later than 30mins late the penalty is exclusion. The penalty free lateness will be extended if there are hold ups on the event. Please try and stick to

your scheduled time.

All regularities except Regularity 1-2 are self start. Start at the next available minute after the previous car. Make sure you enter your start time on your time card and get it signed by a marshal at the next control.

At Regularity 1-2 your start time is the same as your finish time at Test 1-8. Remember to start your clock for the regularity section as you stop at the finish of Test 1-8. Once you have had your time card filled in you should proceed immediately into the regularity section.

Please ensure you get your cards filled in at each control and that you hand them in at the defined card collect points.

6. Penalties

At Regularity Intermediate Time Controls there will be a maximum penalty of 120s.

7. Identification

Please attach the rally plates to the front of your car with the small numbers fitted on or below the rear side windows.

9. Classes

Classes Class H4A and H4B have been amalgamated.

Novices may win awards in the class they are in but there will also be an award for the highest placed Novice.

12. Special Tests

You are not allowed to walk the tests. Do not go beyond the start line.

You must stop astride the finish line, front wheels in front, rear wheels behind.

If there is a stop astride just before the finish line you should stop at that and then continue to stop astride at the finish line. Your time will be taken at the finish line.

Any penalties that you incur will be added to the results, they will not be entered on your timecard.

Remember to mark any codes on the timecard in ink.

Any speed between 15 mph and 30 mph may be used.

You will be timed to the second, the marshal will give you the time that you STOP at his control.


