### **ARTICLE 1 ANNOUNCEMENT**

- 1.1 Berwick & District Motor Club Ltd (BDMC) will organise a RS Clubman permit Navigational Scatter Rally on Saturday 26<sup>th</sup> of July 2025, starting at JS45, East Ord Industrial Estate, Berwick upon Tweed, TD15 2XF.
- 1.2 The event will be a qualifying round of the following championship Berwick & District Motor Club Championship.

#### **ARTICLE 2 JURISDICTION**

2.1 The event will be held under the General Regulations of the Motorsport UK Ltd (incorporating the provisions of the International Sporting Code of the FIA), these Supplementary Regulations and any written instructions the Organisers may issue for the event. All references shown in italics contained within these Supplementary Regulations refer to the appropriate section of the 2025 Competitors' and Officials' Yearbook, available online at: <u>Motorsport UK NCR 2025 v9 [Updated 26/03/2025]</u>

#### **ARTICLE 3 AUTHORISATION**

3.1 Motorsport UK Permit Number: TBC

#### **ARTICLE 4 ELIGIBILITY**

4.1 This event is open to all members of Berwick & District Motor Club (BDMC) and all members of the A.N.E.C.C.C only.

4.2 All competitors must produce a valid club membership card at signing on and must also produce a valid Motorsport UK RS Clubman (Free of Charge) Competition Licence, or higher. Application can be done online prior to the event. through the Motorsport UK website, <a href="https://motorsportuk.sport80.com/home">https://motorsportuk.sport80.com/home</a>

**4.3** Please remember that you now require a minimum of an RS Clubman licence to compete on any Motorsport Uk sanctioned event, also please apply for your licence as early as possible before the actual event as you will not be permitted to take part without it.

#### **ARTICLE 5 PROGRAMME**

5.1 The timetable for the event is as follows: -

Entries open upon publication of these regulations

Entries close on Tuesday 22<sup>nd</sup> of July

Signing on opens at 16.30 on Saturday the 26<sup>th</sup> of July 2025

Signing on closes at 17.15 on Saturday the 26th of July 2025

Signing on will take place at JS45, East Ord Industrial Estate, Berwick upon Tweed, TD15 2XF

First vehicle will start at 17.45 on Saturday the 26<sup>th</sup> of July 2025

First vehicle will finish at approximately 19.45 on Saturday the 26th of July 2025

Final results will be published approximately 30 minutes after the provisional results.

### **ARTICLE 6 SIGNING ON**

6.1 Signing-on will be available on Saturday the 26<sup>th</sup> of July 2025 from 16.30 until 17.15. Any competitor not signed on by 17.15hrs on Saturday the 26th of July 2025 will be excluded.

6.2 All vehicles must be taxed, MOT'd and insured for use on the public highway.

6.3 Vehicles must be presented in a clean condition.

# **ARTICLE 7 ROUTE INSTRUCTIONS**

7.1 Cars will leave the start venue approximately 2 minutes apart.

The event will have a total mileage of approximately 100 miles.

Map number 74/75 will be required.

Types of navigation which may be used: Grid References, Place Names or Areas

There will be 20 locations to find, each location will be worth points from 1 - 5

There is no merit in finding more than 75% of the locations

The finish will be at JS45, East Ord Industrial Estate, Berwick upon Tweed, TD15 2XF.

9.3 The minimum number of entries is 10. The Organisers reserve the right to cancel the event should the minimum number of entries not be reached by the closing date.
